Celebrate water access and the Three Rivers Water Trail's newest port at Westhall Street!

Friends of the Riverfront is proud to announce the addition of a new non-motorized river access and Interpretive Signage at Westhall Street on the North Side. This access joins a network of others in the region as part of the Three Rivers Water Trail and Three Rivers Heritage Trail Interpretive Signage systems. Trail users and members of the public are invited to celebrate on **Saturday, October 23rd at 10am** at the Westhall Street Trail access, **2000 Westhall St. Pittsburgh, PA 15233**. A reception will follow where food and beverage will be provided.

Planning for this project began several years ago as part of the expansion of the Three Rivers Water Trail system, connecting the North Side neighborhoods with non-motorized boat access to the Ohio River. Directions to Westhall Street:

From West End Bridge:

- Turn LEFT take Ohio River Blvd/US 19/Chateau St. ramp
- Take Chateau Street ramp
- Stay Straight on Chateau which becomes Beaver Ave. and then Preble Ave.
- Turn LEFT onto Westhall Street.

From I-376 West:

- Take I-79 N exit 70C to Fort Duquesne Bridge/North Shore
- Stay Straight onto Ft. Pitt Blvd to I-279
- Take the PA 65 N exit 1 B-C on left towards Ohio River Blvd.
- Merge onto 65 N using exit 1C
- Take the Chateau St./West End Bridge exit towards Western Ave.
- Take the Chateau St. ramp
- Follow directions from Chateau Street above.
