



Riverfronts Naturally Volunteer Stewardship

- When:** Friday, August 14th from 5:00 to 8:00 pm
- Location:** Duck Hollow and adjacent Monongahela River riparian buffer zone along the Duck Hollow Trail.
- Directions:** From downtown Pittsburgh take route 376 East to the Squirrel Hill/Homestead exit. Proceed straight towards Homestead on Brownhill Road. When the road becomes two lanes stay in the left lane and turn left onto Old Brownhill Road (light adjacent to Wendy's) then proceed down the hill to the Duck Hollow Pier. We will assemble in the parking lot adjacent to the Friends of the Riverfront tent and banner. See map below for additional details. - Tasks:** Participants will be performing general riverfront stewardship including removal of invasive plant species and tending/planting native trees and shrubs. Please dress appropriately for the task. We recommend comfortable shoes, long pants and long sleeve shirt to avoid being scratched while removing overgrowth. The trail area where we will focus our attention may require removal of trash and recyclables.
- We provide:** We will provide refreshments, work gloves, safety glasses and all other tools and materials along with first aid if needed.
- Schedule:** 5:00 – 5:30 pm Welcome, orientation and safety briefing.
5:30 – 7:30 pm Trail service and maintenance.
7:30 – 8:00 pm Clean up, debrief and refreshments.
