- Directions:** From downtown Pittsburgh take Boulevard of the Allies to 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue (roadway is to the right of the Liberty Bridge onramp). Follow 2<sup>nd</sup> Avenue away from downtown. Make a Left onto Swinburne Street. Signs will direct you to Eliza Furnace Trail Head parking where we will assemble at the Friends of the Riverfront trail work site.
