### **International Coastal Clean-up**

**Location:** Lawrenceville Riverfront Trail and adjacent Allegheny River riparian buffer zone.

**Directions:** From downtown Pittsburgh take Liberty Avenue and turn left onto 40<sup>th</sup> Street. Proceed towards the 40<sup>th</sup> Street Bridge, turn right just before the bridge and continue to proceed on 40<sup>th</sup> Street. Park at the trail head adjacent to Carnegie Robots Center. We will assemble there next to the PA CleanWays and Friends of the Riverfront banner adjacent to the trail. See map below for additional details. **Tasks:** Participants will be performing general riverfront stewardship including removal of invasive plant species and tending/planting native trees and shrubs. Please dress appropriately for the task. We recommend comfortable shoes, long pants and long sleeve shirt to avoid being scratched while removing overgrowth. The trail area where we will focus our attention may require removal of trash and recyclables.
