- When:** Friday, July 10th from 5:00 to 8:00 pm
- Location:** Plum Borough and adjacent Allegheny River riparian buffer zone.
- Directions:** From downtown Pittsburgh follow Route 28 North, take exit # 9 Blawnox and travel through Blawnox, turn right to cross the Hulton Bridge into Oakmont, stay straight onto Route 909 for 5 miles, turn left onto Barking Road. - Tasks:** Participants will be performing general riverfront stewardship including removal of rubbish and recyclables. Please dress appropriately for the task. We recommend comfortable shoes, long pants and long sleeve shirt to avoid being scratched while removing overgrowth.
