



Riverfronts Naturally Volunteer Stewardship

- When:** Wednesday, May 21st, 2008 from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm
- Location:** South Side Trailhead at 4th Street part of the Three Rivers Heritage Trail.
- Directions:** From downtown Pittsburgh take Smithfield Street Bridge across the Monongahela and Left onto East Carson Street. Proceed away from Station Square for ½ mile and make a Left onto 1st Street and an immediate Right onto McKean Street. Follow McKean until it intersects with Bingham Street. At the Roadway intersection turn Left and head onto 4th Street, a cobble stone alley leading towards the Monongahela River. At the end of 4th Street cross the railroad tracks and turn Right into the New South Side Trailhead parking area. Once parked we will assemble adjacent to the large earthen mound, look for the blue registration tent and Friends of the Riverfront banner. See map below for additional details. - Tasks:** Participants will be performing a planting of native trees, shrubs and sunflowers along this new trail segment. Please dress appropriately for the task. We recommend work boots, long pants and long sleeve shirt to avoid being scratched while removing overgrowth. The riverfront trail area where we will focus our attention will require removal invasive plants along with rubbish and recyclables.
- We provide:** We will provide work gloves for all, safety glasses for those who might need them, all the tools and materials along with first aid if needed. Refreshments will also be provided.
