- Location:** South Side Riverfront Park and adjacent Monongahela River riparian buffer zone along the South Side Riverfront Trail.
- Directions:** From downtown Pittsburgh take the Smithfield Street Bridge and turn left onto East Carson Street. Proceed through the South side and turn Left onto 18<sup>th</sup> Street, it will lead you directly into South Side Riverfront Park. We will assemble in the parking area beneath the Birmingham Bridge. See map below for additional details. - Tasks:** Participants will be performing general riverfront stewardship including removal of invasive plant species and tending/planting native trees and shrubs. Please dress appropriately for the task. We recommend comfortable shoes, long pants and long sleeve shirt to avoid being scratched while removing overgrowth. The trail area where we will focus our attention may require removal of trash and recyclables.
